

**High Streamflow Advisory** – Stream levels are rising or expected to rise rapidly and <u>no major flooding</u> is expected. Minor flooding in lowlying areas is possible. Anyone situated close to the streams affected is advised to be cautious of the rising levels.

**Flood Watch** – Stream levels are rising and will approach or may exceed bank full. Flooding of areas adjacent to these streams may occur. Anyone situated close to the river is advised to take appropriate precautionary measures.

**Flood Warning** – Rising stream levels will result in flooding of areas adjacent to the streams affected. Anyone situated close to the river should take appropriate measures to avoid flood damage.



## **Streamflow Advisory Overview for Alberta**

Advisories apply to streams and their tributaries unless otherwise noted.

- The upper ridge that was situated over Alberta during the long weekend is being pushed out by a strong cold front which currently extends from High Level to Grande Prairie. As it drives eastwards across the province today, there is a high risk of severe thunderstorms with large hail possible for regions in central and north-eastern Alberta. Some thunderstorm activity is also possible along the southern eastern slopes.
- Generally stable conditions are forecast for northern and central Alberta tomorrow, while the southern portion eastern slopes is forecast to have shower and thundershower activity in the wake of the cold front.
- A trough is expected to move into Alberta on Thursday with a forecast of up to 40 mm of precipitation over a 24 hr period for the regions between Edson and Sundre. Regions south of Sundre along the foothills and Rockies are forecast to have shower and thundershower activity with amounts up to 20 mm into Friday afternoon.
